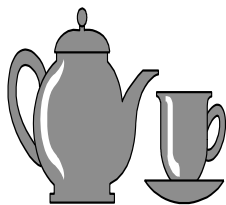
Thank you all who have participated in this special drive. We have so far raised \$5000.00 designated for the Matchmaker Fund, 10% of our goal.

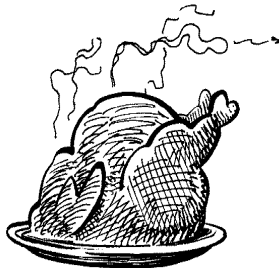

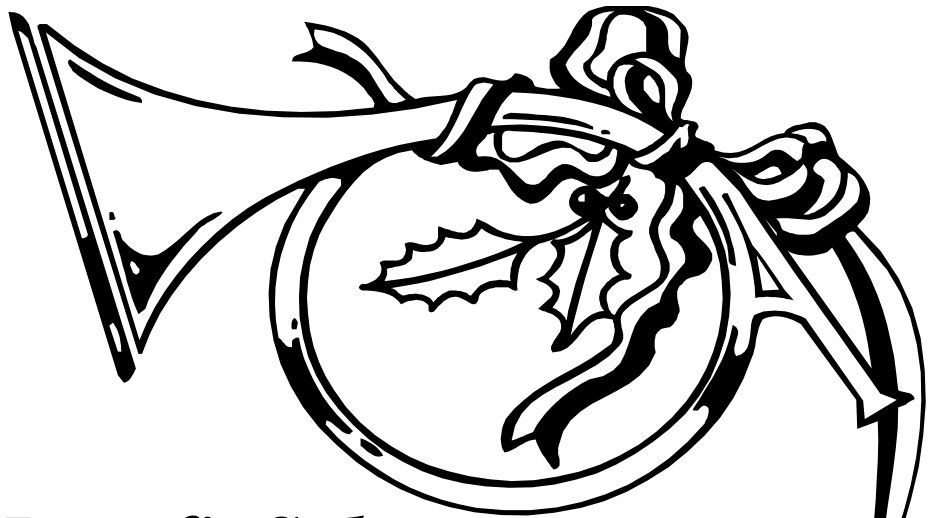
